

## Monthly Activity Planner (Pre – School – Pre – Primary)

---

### APRIL

1. Finger Painting – Let your child paint with fingers instead of brushes.
2. Playdough Shapes – Roll, press, and cut shapes.
3. Paper Collage – Tear coloured paper and stick onto a big sheet.
4. Stamp Art – Use potatoes or sponge cut-outs as stamps.
5. Alphabet Hunt – Hide letters around the house for your child to find.

### MAY

6. Sorting Game – Sort toys by colour or size.
7. Counting With Beads – String beads while counting.
8. Shape Tracing – Get kids to trace household objects on paper.
9. Animal Walks – Hop like a bunny, crawl like a crab, or waddle like a duck.
10. Balloon Toss – Keep a balloon in the air for as long as possible.

### JULY

11. Obstacle Course – Use child-safe objects and guide them across.
12. Dance Freeze – Dance to music and freeze when it stops.
13. Fruit Tasting Game – Try sweet, sour, crunchy fruits.
14. Scooping & Transferring – Move rice/beans between bowls using spoons.
15. Magnet Play – Discover what sticks to a magnet.

### AUGUST

16. Shape Hunt At Home – Find circles, squares, or triangles around the house.
17. Nature Walk – Collect leaves, stones, or flowers.
18. Chalk Art – Draw on the pavement or garden floor.
19. Bubble Play – Blow and chase bubbles.
20. Follow The Leader – Copy each other's movements.
13. Fruit Tasting Game – Try sweet, sour, crunchy fruits.

### SEPTEMBER

21. Hopscotch – Draw squares and hop over.
22. Parachute Play – Use a bedsheet and toss soft balls on it.

23. Rolling Races – Roll across the floor or grass.

24. Animal Charades – Act like animals and guess.

25. Puzzle Time – Try simple puzzles together.

### OCTOBER

26. Ball Rolling Maze – Roll a ball through a home-made path.

27. Ring Toss – Toss rings or bangles onto a target.

28. Table Setting – Place spoons, forks, and plates.

29. Simple Chores – Wipe a table or dust.

30. Snack Preparation – Spread butter or peel bananas.

### NOVEMBER

31. Sand Play – Scoop, pour, and build.

32. Water Play – Splash, fill, and empty containers.

33. Gardening Together – Dig soil, sow seeds, and water plants.

34. Shadow Play – Make shapes with your body in the sun.

35. Storytelling – Read aloud and ask questions.

### DECEMBER

36. Colour Mixing – Mix paints or coloured water to discover new colours.

37. Matching Cards – Pair animals, shapes, or pictures.

38. Calm Drawing – Provide art supplies and a calm space where children can get creative.

39. Sticker Play – Stick and peel stickers on paper.

40. Threading Buttons – Thread a thick thread through large buttons.

### JANUARY

41. Quiet Reading Corner – Create a cosy reading nook and set aside one hour every day to enjoy it.

42. Sorting Pictures – Sort pictures into groups (animals, food).

43. Role Play – Pretend to be shopkeeper, doctor, or chef.

44. Dress Up – Use scarves, hats, and old clothes.

45. Building Blocks – Stack and design towers.

## FEBRUARY

46. Sing-Along Time - Sing nursery rhymes together.
47. Guess The Sound - Close eyes and guess sounds.
48. Sorting Buttons - Sort buttons by size or colour.
49. Paper Folding - Simple origami like boats.
50. Ice Cube Rescue - Freeze small toys in ice and let children melt or break them out using warm water or spoons.
